Based on the Jazz Piano Secrets Week 2 Neo Jazz Progression

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Cell 1 | Cell 2

Cmaj9 A♭maj9 Am11 B♭13(sus4) E♭maj9 E♯maj9(♯5) A♭m11 G7(♯9)

Cell 1 Permutation Examples

Cell 1 - Permutation 1: Full Cell Backwards | Permutation 2: Each Bar Backwards

5 B♭13(sus4) Am11 A♭maj9 Cmaj9 A♭maj9 Cmaj9 B♭13(sus4) Am11

Permutation 3: Bar 1 Backwards, Bar 2 Forwards | Permutation 4: Bar 1 Forwards, Bar 2 Backwards

9 A♭maj9 Cmaj9 Am11 B♭13(sus4) Cmaj9 A♭maj9 B♭13(sus4) Am11

Cell 2 Permutation Examples

Permutation 1: Full Cell Backwards

Permutation 2: Each Bar Backwards

13 G7([#]5) Abm¹¹ Emaj9([#]5) Ebmaj9 Emaj9([#]5) Ebmaj9 G7([#]5) Abm¹¹

Permutation 3: Bar 1 Backwards, Bar 2 Forwards

Permutation 4: Bar 1 Forwards, Bar 2 Backwards

17 Emaj9([#]5) Ebmaj9 Abm¹¹ G7([#]5) Ebmaj9 Emaj9([#]5) G7([#]5) Abm¹¹

2-Cell Permutation Examples

Cell 1 - Permutation 1: Full Cell Backwards

Cell 2 - Permutation 1: Full Cell Backwards

21 Bb13(sus4) Am¹¹ Abmaj9 Cmaj9 G7([#]5) Abm¹¹ Emaj9([#]5) Ebmaj9

Cell 2 - Permutation 4: Bar 1 Forwards, Bar 2 Backwards

Cell 1 - Permutation 3: Bar 1 Backwards, Bar 2 Forwards

25 Ebmaj9 Emaj9([#]5) G7([#]5) Abm¹¹ Abmaj9 Cmaj9 Am¹¹ Bb13(sus4)

Cell 1 - Permutation 4: Bar 1 Forwards, Bar 2 Backwards

Cell 2 - Permutation 3: Bar 1 Backwards, Bar 2 Forwards

29 Cmaj9 A \flat maj9 B \flat 13(sus4) Am11 E \sharp maj9(5) E \flat maj9 A \flat m11 G7(\sharp 9/ \sharp 5)

Cell 1 - Permutation 4: Bar 1 Forwards, Bar 2 Backwards

Cell 2 - Permutation 1: Full Cell Backwards

33 Cmaj9 A \flat maj9 B \flat 13(sus4) Am11 G7(\sharp 9/ \sharp 5) A \flat m11 E \sharp maj9(5) E \flat maj9
